Vehicle Crashes into Residence on Middleburg Plain City Road

The Union County Sheriff's Office and the Multi County Crash Investigation Team are investigating a serious injury crash that occurred in the 14000 block of Middleburg Plain City Road on September 3, 2018.

At approximately 1:19 am, the Sheriff's Office received a 9-1-1 call reporting a vehicle had crashed into a residence. Deputies and units from the Jerome Township Fire Department, the Marysville Fire Department, and the Pleasant Valley Fire Distract responded to the scene and found a 1997 Honda Accord resting against a residence. The preliminary investigation has determined that the Honda Accord was traveling eastbound when it crossed the center line and drove off the left side of the road. The Honda then drove through a ditch, struck a fence, and ran over a pine tree before coming to rest against the residence. Excessive speed has been identified as a factor in the crash. The driver of the Honda, Sherilyn Davis age 29 of Plain City, was transported by the Jerome Township Fire Department to Dublin Methodist Hospital and was later flown by Medflight to the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. The Union County Emergency Management Agency and the Ohio State Highway Patrol assisted at the scene. Middleburg Plain City Road was closed until approximately 5:35 am this morning while the crash was investigated.
