Deputy Injured at Hinton Mill Road Incident

On November 20, 2018, at approximately 4:03 pm, the Union County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence in the 14000 block of Hinton Mill Road in Dover Township to investigate a domestic dispute between a husband and wife. Deputies were able to resolve the domestic dispute and the parties were separated.

At approximately 5:44 pm, the Sheriff's Office received a second 9-1-1 call from the wife involved in the previous domestic dispute stating that her husband was threatening to commit suicide. Deputies responded to the same residence and found the husband under the influence. After trying to convince the husband to be evaluated at a medical facility, a struggle ensued which resulted in a deputy receiving a laceration to the face and a hematoma to the left eye. The deputy and the husband were transported to Memorial Hospital where they treated and released. The husband has been identified as Cameron R. Hastings, age 31 of Marysville. He was arrested for Obstructing Official Business, a felony of the fifth degree, and transported to Tri-County Regional Jail in Mechanicsburg. Hastings appeared in the Marysville Municipal Court this morning and his bond was set at \$100,000.00. A preliminary hearing has been scheduled for November 29, 2018.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted at the scene by the Marysville Division of Police and the Marysville Division of Fire. The incident remains under investigation.
