Preliminary Engineer Construction Estimate \$742K. Included Additive bid 1 that includes the apron area not addressed previously. Preliminary Engineer Construction Estimate \$88k. Submitted plans to ODOT BlackCat have not received comments.

UNION COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY MINUTES FEBRUARY 11, 2020

The Union County Airport Authority held its regular monthly meeting on Feb. 11, 2020. This meeting was held at the Union County Airport, 760 Clymer Road, Marysville, Ohio and was called to order by President John Popio at 4:03 pm. Mr. Philip LaPointe and Mr. Shaun Bailey were the only other members present. Excused or absent members were Mr. Ken Denman, Mr. Bruce Rausch, Mr. Bob Chapman, and Mr. Jim Mitchell. Guests present were Mr. Tyler Bicknell for Woolpert, Mr. Thayne Gray from the Union County Prosecutor's office and Mr. Dave Holden from Skyvista. Since there weren't enough members present for a quorum the board could not conduct official business but did discuss the following issues.

The board agreed to pay the attached list of bills since they were all allowable and budgeted for in this year's budget.

Mr. Popio reported that he contacted Jordan's Concrete and they will come back out when weather permits and take care of the sealing and other issues regarding the concrete pad they did in December. He stated that the liability insurance has been filed and all is good with that. He contacted Wade Branstiter at the Auditor's office and got a quote for a camera for the desktop computer of less than \$200. This hopefully will allow better access for teleconferencing in the future. He also reported that Mr. Jim Mitchell (term will end 6-30-2020) wishes to resign as of February 11, 2020. Mr. Popio discussed the possibility of getting someone involved with the city to take his place. He felt this might foster more and better communication with the city. He will continue to work on this.

Mr. Gray attended the meeting to report on the progress or lack thereof on the land acquisition. There seems to be problems on both sides that he is trying to work out. He will try to get some resolution and report at the next meeting.

Mr. Holden from Skyvista reported that there are still 4 outstanding leases for the T Hangars. They have been contacted and three have now returned their lease. Mr. Popio stated that if the lease of the 4th is not returned soon they will be considered a month to month tenant and should be advised of that. Mr. Holden stated that there still some leaky spots in the roof that need to be addressed. He stated that he will also work with Mt Vernon Door to get repairs done on T Hangar doors. There are some issues with the pilot's lighting and he will work with Jess Howard to get these resolved.

Mr. Bicknell gave the report from Woolpert. (See Attached). Mr. Popio reminded him that we really need to get going on the Master Plan as soon as possible.
