Bids shall be addressed to the attention of the Union County Airport, Steve Koenig, 760 Clymer Road, Marysville, OH, Marysville, OH, 43040, and will be clearly marked "Sealed Bid: REPLACE RUNWAY 9-27 PAPIs AND POWER CABLE. DO NOT OPEN". Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 11:00 a.m. (local time) in the Union County Airport Terminal Building, 760 Clymer Road, Marysville, OH 43040.

The work involved will include the following:

Replace Runway 9-27 PAPIs including new cable, conduit and junction boxes.

L-108-5.2 Install #8 AWG Ground Wire - 4,000 LF

L-108-5.3 Install #6 AWG, Solid, Bare Copper Counterpoise Including Ground Rods and Connections/Terminations - 4,000 LF

L-110-5.1 Install 1-2" SCH. 40 PVC Duct, Direct Earth Buried - 3,400 LF

L-110-5.2 Install 1-2" SCH. 40 HDPE Duct, Directionally Bored - 525 LF

L-115-5.1 Install L-867B Junction Box, Complete - 8 EA

L-125-5.1 Remove L-880 PAPI System from Existing Bases, Complete - 2 EA

L-125-5.2 Install L-880 LED PAPI System, Complete - 2 EA

Pre-Bid Conference. A **MANDATORY** pre-bid conference and project site visit for this project will be held on **Wednesday, January 21, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. (local time)**, in the Terminal Building Conference Room at the Union County Airport, 760 Clymer Road, Marysville, Ohio.

Bid Conditions. All bidders shall make arrangements with the Union County Airport to examine the site to become familiar with all site conditions prior to submitting their bid.

The bidder is required to provide all information as required within the Contract Documents. The bidder is required to bid on all items of every schedule or as otherwise detailed in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids may be held by Owner for a period not to exceed 90 calendar days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of evaluating bids prior to award of contract.

No Bidder may withdraw its bid after the bid has been opened. The Union County Airport Authority reserves the right to waive any informality in bidding and to reject any and all bids.

Bid Bond. Guarantee will be required with each bid as a certified check on a solvent bank or a Bid Bond in the amount of five (5) % of the total amount of the bid, made payable to the Union County Airport Authority.

Performance & Payment Bond. The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate performance and payment bonds each in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price.
