

RESOLUTION NO. 25-530

A RESOLUTION UNDER OHIO ADMIN CODE 120-1-12 APPROVING THE PUBLIC DEFENDER COMMISSION'S REQUEST FOR FUNDS TO MEET THE OBLIGATIONS UNDER A CONTRACT WITH UNION COUNTY CRIMINAL DEFENSE LAWYERS FOR PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICES IN 2026.

WHEREAS, the Union County Public Defender Commission and the Union County Criminal Defense Lawyers have negotiated terms of a contract for public defender services in Union County during 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Public Defender Commission has requested the Board of County Commissioners approve and appropriate Six Hundred-Seventy-Three Thousand, Five Hundred-Eighty-Five Dollars (\$673,585.00) to meet all of the total obligations under the proposed contract; and

WHEREAS, under Admin Code 120-1-12(D), this Board must approve sufficient funds to meet the contract obligations before the Public Defender Commissioner can sign the contract;

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, UNION COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Six Hundred-Seventy-Three Thousand, Five Hundred-Eighty-Five Dollars (\$673,585.00), being the amount required to meet all of the total obligations under the proposed public defender services contract between the Union County Public Defender Commissioner and Union County Criminal Defense Lawyers is approved.

Section 2. The Union County Public Defender Commission is authorized to enter into the proposed contract for public defender services by Union County Criminal Defense Lawyers in 2026.

Section 3. The Board finds and determines that all of its formal actions concerning and relating to adopting this Resolution occurred in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Revised Code §121.22.

Dave Lawrence introduced this resolution and moved its passage; Tom McCarthy seconded the motion; and after discussion, the chair called a roll call vote, and the results were:



AGREEMENT

This Agreement made at Marysville, Ohio, effective as of January 1, 2026, between the Union County Public Defender Commission, Union County, Ohio, ("Commission"), and Union County Criminal Defense Lawyers, an Ohio nonprofit corporation, ("UCCDL"), and as to financial matters, the Board of County Commissioners, Union County Ohio (the "Board").

WHEREAS, the Board, by Resolution, established the Commission on October 9, 1997; and,

WHEREAS, the Commission is obligated by Ohio Revised Code § 120.14 to provide legal counsel to represent indigent persons in the proceedings identified in division (A) of §120.16 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, under Ohio Revised Code § 120.14(F), the Commission may contract with a nonprofit corporation for the provision of services under §120.14; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2025, before this Agreement was signed, the Board adopted Resolution No. 25- 530, Commissioners' Journal No. 2025, approving the entire amount required for a contract with a non-profit organization to provide legal services to indigent persons, as required by Ohio Administrative Code §120-1- 12(D); and

WHEREAS, the Board did not interfere with the Commission's selection of the non-profit organization to provide the services under this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Union County Commissioners passed Resolution No. 25 -530 on December 17, 2025, Commissioners' Journal No. 2025, authorizing a contract between the Commission and UCCDL for indigent representation from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, UCCDL has the primary purpose of providing legal representation to indigent persons and can provide competent legal counsel to indigents in criminal and certain other juvenile matters; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to contract with UCCDL, and UCCDL desires to undertake the statutory obligations of the County Public Defender in Union County Common Pleas Court, General (Criminal) Division, Juvenile Division, Probate Division, and Marysville Municipal Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties set forth herein, the parties agree that:

1. The term of this Agreement shall be from January 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026.
2. UCCDL agrees to provide the following statutory services of a county public defender as required or permitted under Ohio Rev. Code Ch. 120., as amended. UCCDL that it will:
 - a. Comply with all standards established by the rules of the Ohio public defender commission.
 - b. Comply with all standards established by the state public defender; and
 - c. Comply with all statutory duties and other laws applicable.
3. UCCDL shall provide in the Union County Common Pleas Court, General (Criminal) Division, Juvenile Division and Probate Division, and Marysville Municipal Court legal representation of indigent adults and juveniles charged with committing an offense or act that violates a state statute and for which the penalty or any possible adjudication includes the potential

loss of liberty; in post-conviction proceedings, as defined in R.C. §120.16, as amended; in parole and probation revocation matters; in matters relating to the revocation of community control or post-release control under a community control sanction or post-release control sanction; and in other required Juvenile and Probate Court matters (i.e., attorneys in abuse, neglect and dependency cases, and contempt issues, but excluding guardian ad litem services) referred to it by the Courts. This Agreement excludes legal representation of persons in cases of alleged homicides with death penalty specifications, and cases where there is an unresolvable conflict of interest. UCCDL shall use its best efforts to independently contract with attorneys to avoid or resolve conflict issues.

4. In all cases within the jurisdiction of Union County, Ohio, during the term of this Agreement, UCCDL shall provide attorneys to eligible defendants at their request or the request of someone acting on their behalf, after service of summons, formal charging, or indictment, provided such indigent persons qualify for representation under the guidelines established by the Ohio Public Defender in Rule 120-1-03 of the Ohio Administrative Code, as amended, which is incorporated herein by reference. UCCDL shall ensure that attorneys shall be accessible to applicants regarding criminal or delinquency matters before formal court appointment.

5. Upon request for indigent representation in appropriate cases, the Court shall refer the individual to UCCDL. UCCDL shall require the requesting individual to complete a Financial Disclosure/Affidavit of Indigence, and/or other forms as required by the Ohio State Public Defender to insure reimbursement by the State of Ohio. UCCDL shall determine indigence of such individuals, subject to review by the Court, as provided in Ohio Rev. Code §120.05. As soon as reasonably possible after receiving a referral, UCCDL shall report back to the Court on its finding of indigence and, if so found, file an Entry of Appearance of Counsel.

6. UCCDL agrees not to discriminate against any employee, independent contractor, or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, or national origin in performing work under this Agreement. UCCDL shall take affirmative action to ensure applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Such action shall include, but not be limited to: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer, recruitment, or recruitment advertising; lay-off or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

7. UCCDL agrees to complete all cases once representation has commenced under this Agreement. Representation commenced in the trial court shall continue through all trial court proceedings, including writs and probation or community control sanction violation proceedings. This provision does not prohibit UCCDL from withdrawing from a case due to an unresolvable conflict of interest recognized by the Court, or from withdrawing due to a finding of the client's financial ineligibility for services. A conflict of interest for an individual attorney providing services does not necessarily mean that UCCDL cannot continue to provide representation through another attorney. The substitution of a different attorney as counsel of record in a case shall not be considered a new referral or appointment to identify the number of cases referred. If a conflict does exist that prevents representation by UCCDL, the Court shall assign a private attorney to represent the indigent client, to be paid from the general fund, subject to the hourly rates and per case caps previously approved by the Board.

8. UCCDL will provide the services of three (3) Full-time Equivalent attorneys as independent contractors. UCCDL shall use its judgment to fill the three (3) full-time equivalent

attorney positions. Attorneys will devote the time necessary to effectively represent the indigent clients.

9. UCCDL shall employ or independently contract support staff and non-attorney personnel as needed to complete the obligations of this contract. All employees, independent contractors, and forensic experts shall be compensated at rates commensurate, with their training, experience, and responsibilities, which rates shall also be comparable to those paid to individuals performing similar work in Union County. Special needs for investigators, social workers, mental health professionals, and other forensic experts to provide competent representation shall be brought to the attention of the Court by ex parte motion for authorization of procuring the services at county cost.

10. UCCDL may request payment in addition to that under this agreement for cases that require an extraordinary amount of time and preparation. The request for such consideration must be approved in advance by the Judge assigned to such case.

11. UCCDL shall retain financial records, submit financial reports, and submit to an annual financial audit. A report of these findings shall be provided to the Commission and shall also be forwarded to the Ohio Public Defender Commission as part of the annual report submitted under Sections 120.14, and 120.24 of the Ohio Revised.

12. UCCDL shall represent all assigned clients in a professional, skilled manner consistent with Ohio Rev. Code Chapter 120, the Rules of the Ohio Public Defender Commission, the Ohio Public Defender Standards, the Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct for attorneys in Ohio, and case law and applicable court rules defining the duties of counsel and the rights of parties in court proceedings. UCCDL shall comply with the qualification and training provisions of OAC §120-1-10, as amended, in assigning attorneys to individual cases and shall follow the workload standards of OAC 120-1-07. UCCDL shall require all attorney independent contractors to meet the attorney qualifications in OAC §120-1-10. The Board shall establish a separate line-item account for training in an amount not less than Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) to be used to pay for training of attorneys and support staff employees in subject matter relevant to their respective job duties. The \$3,500.00 shall be payable on January 1, 2026. Any unused or undocumented funds from the \$3,500.00 shall be returned to the General Fund by December 31, 2026.

13. UCCDL shall require all attorney independent contractors to provide proof of legal malpractice insurance in minimum amounts of \$100,000 per claim and \$300,000 in the aggregate.

14. UCCDL shall maintain a case reporting and management information system and data from the system shall be available and provided, upon request, to the appropriate courts of Union County, the Board of Commissioners of Union County, and the Public Defender Commission of Union County. However, no information shall be required to be released that may be deemed to breach the attorney-client privilege. UCCDL shall report the caseload data to the State Public Defender, the Union County Public Defender Commission, and appropriate Union County officials monthly or as required by the State Public Defender.



Union County shall pay to UCCDL for services provided during 2026, the total amount of Six Hundred-Seventy Thousand, Eighty-Five Dollars (\$670,085.00) for public defender services in the Marysville Municipal Court, the Union County Common Pleas Court (General, Juvenile, and Probate Divisions), and administration, payable in one payment of \$ 55,840.49-- on January 1,


2026, and monthly installments of \$55,840.41 on the first of the next eleven months. Said sums shall be appropriated by the Board of Commissioners of Union County and be available to meet the requirements under this agreement. The Board shall appropriate the funds necessary to fulfill the training requirements under this Agreement. UCCDL shall submit its monthly invoice for any payment to this Agreement to the Board of County Commissioners to review and approve for payment.

16. UCCDL agrees to immediately renegotiate the terms of this contract with the Commission should any Judge in the Courts where UCCDL is contracted to practice decides that his or her Court will no longer participate in this system of representation.


