Ms. Kuhlwein stated the article that was on the front page of the Marysville Journal Tribune was a shock she felt the Union County Fair Board deserved to share their feelings. She thanked the Commissioners for their support in the past. In 2023, the study that was referenced in the Union County Leadership presentations last week was done. Members of the Union County Fair Board and the Richwood Independent Fair Board met. It was a good conversation, and she would like residents of Union County to know the county fair is a good fair. She was taken aback by the comments made by the Commissioners regarding the fairgrounds and would like to know how they can move forward from this.

Commissioner McCarthy stated the presentation was through the Chamber of Commerce. They do a leadership class every year, and everyone must complete a project. Commissioner Robinson attended the presentations back in May and asked this specific group to present to the Board. There was no ulterior motive.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated this potentially pitted two communities against each other. Both fair boards get along very well, and neither have talked about merging the two fairs. There have been multiple social media posts regarding this, and she would like everyone to be conscious of what they post on social media. The fair is about the kids in the community. The funding from the Commissioners has been the same every year. They were also receiving the county bed tax, but that process has changed. She has sent an email to the Commissioners Office and has not heard anything back.

Commissioner McCarthy stated there has been a staffing change in the office and the fair needs to be conscious of that.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated this is not the first time she has not gotten a reply. There have been prior capital projects she has inquired about and has gotten no reply.

Mr. Narducci stated moving forward he will commit to being better at communicating with the fair. He cannot guarantee and funds for capital projects, but he will give a timely answer.

Ms. Quick stated there are almost 900 exhibitors for the 2025 Union County Fair. Last year around 300 kids sold animals in the livestock sale, and close to \$500,000 goes back to those kids. Kids learn a lot financially and socially from being part of junior fair and look forward to this every year. The community is growing, and it is up to leadership to show the positives of this. The fairgrounds can be an asset to the community.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated the fairgrounds is used by the community throughout the year. It is a disaster site for Marysville High School, and people camped there when two national shows happened in the community last year. Additionally, the Hope Center was housed there for three years.

Commissioner Lawrence stated there was nothing negative said about the Union County Fair in the presentation, and Commissioner McCarthy agreed.

Ms. Jenkins stated the fair runs July 20 - July 26 and asked the Commissioner how they would be willing to help fund the fair in the future.

Commissioner McCarthy stated there are currently two bills in the state legislature that could substantially impact the budget if they are passed.

Mr. Jenkins stated the Commissioners helped the Richwood Independent Fair with two capital projects, and he would like to know how they got funding, but Union County cannot.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated the Richwood Independent Fair received \$59,000 in 2023, and Commissioners Steve Robinson and Dave Burke signed on the paperwork. The Union County Fair Board has raised money for the new beef barn on their grounds, and they are still paying for it. They have received some grant funding from the state as well in the past.

Inge Witt arrived at this time.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated there are approximately 900 junior fair entries at Union County and the Richwood Independent Fair only has 285. They have a significant amount more of bills and expenses because they are a bigger fair.

Commissioner McCarthy asked who carries the insurance on the building on the fairgrounds, and Ms. Kuhlwein stated the Commissioners do, but the fair carries its own liability. The costs for liability insurance have increased significantly. Their current coverage has gone up to \$54,000, and they are working on looking at new policies to save some money.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated the community thinks money only comes from the fair gates and buildings. They do not realize how expensive operating costs are. It is important to get the support of the Commissioners.

Ms. Jenkins stated Union County is blessed to have two fairs.

Commissioner McCarthy stated the county does not own the fairgrounds, but they will look at capital project requests from the fair. However, the Board has to prioritize county funds. He cannot say what has happened in the past with previous Commissioners and funding.

Ms. Kuhlwein stated it would be beneficial to look at Delaware County's bed tax and how it funds the fair. The bed tax funding in Union County has not been looked at in a long time and she suggested it be done and changed in the future.

The future development is being master planned to capitalize on the area's existing automotive and tech assets and will provide increased capacity for the industry to grow in the region as it transitions to batteryelectric from internal combustion vehicles.



TRC Expansion

The Transportation Research Center Inc. (TRC) broke ground on a new \$25 M, 66,000-square-foot Impact Laboratory to support the National Highway Transportation Administration Vehicle and Testing Center. It is designed to accommodate advanced testing for electric and autonomous vehicles and improve high-impact collision testing capabilities. Construction is expected to be completed by Spring 2026.
