- Met earlier this with representatives from Jerome Township and the City of Marysville regarding utility service in the JEDD and the CEDA Agreement. The CEDA Agreement allows an income tax to be put onto new businesses in the JEDD. The goal is to notify businesses of this income tax and to timely add new businesses to the JEDD. Jerome Township can possibly include this requirement when the company gets their zoning permit. The group also discussed the Asset Purchase Agreement. They do not want to have multiple utility providers competing in the same area.
- Yesterday, he and Commissioner McCarthy attended the crisis communication training. It was all day, but very good training about communicating with the public and being transparent during crisis situations. There were approximately 50 people there, and every county office was represented.
- Cheryl Subler from CCAO reached out to him early this morning. The inside millage has not been impacted by the passed budget on the state level. There are changes the county can make to help lessen the impacts of property taxes. It is not perfect, but it is not the worst from a county perspective. The ballot initiative to remove property taxes is still moving forward, and they will continue to monitor that.
