RE: Driveway Variance for a newly created 10.48 Acre parcel located on Ketch Rd.

Matthew Heater is requesting a Driveway Variance for a newly created 10.48-acre parcel located on Ketch Road created from a 25.28-acre parent parcel:1500030410000.

Ketch Road is a minor collector road with a current daily traffic count of approximately 379 vehicles per day (2023 count). As a minor collector, the minimum driveway spacing as established by our Access Management Regulations is 360 ft. With the current speed limit of 55 mph, the minimum driveway required sight distance is 495 ft.

A new drive access located 157' north of an existing driveway located at 9559 Ketch Road has been proposed, utilizing a joint access easement provided as a part of this property split. The new location does meet our sight-distance requirements but does not meet our driveway spacing requirements, as the new drive is less than 360' from the existing drive.

Because the proposed location meets our sight distance requirements, I recommend a variance be granted for placement of the driveway in the proposed location.

This approval is conditional to the following:

Any future development of the remaining 14.80-acre parcel may be required to utilize the 2-acre easement for both the 10.48-acres and the remaining 14.80-acres. If the remaining 14.80-acres were to be developed into a major subdivision, the access for both tracts may require a relocated access point approximately 200 to 250 feet northwest of the 2-acre easement location, and the Developer of the remaining 14.80-acres shall grant access to the 10.48-acre parcel as part of their development plan. This would require removal of this "variance approved" access for the 10.48-acre tract.

The future access locations/approvals shall be at the discretion of the Engineer. The above access conditions shall be approved through a recorded Agreement between the Parties (attached).

ACCESS EASEMENT

THIS ACCESS EASEMENT (this "Easement") is made as of the day of, 2025, by and between Howard William Wren, married; Dorothy E. Bleam, married; Michael Wren, unmarried and Laurie Coleman, unmarried (collectively, "Grantor"), having a mailing address of and Matthew Heater and Brittany Heater, husband and wife (collectively, the "Grantee"), having a mailing address of
RECITALS
A. The Grantor is the owner of real property known as Union County Parcel Identification Number 15-0003041.0000, as further described on $\underline{\text{Exhibit A}}$ attached hereto (the "Grantor Parcel").
B. Grantee is the owner of real property known as Union County Parcel Identification Numbers, as further described on <u>Exhibit B</u> attached hereto (the " <u>Benefitted Parcel</u> "). The Grantor Parcel and the Benefitted Parcel shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the "Entire Parcel".
C. Grantee requested that Grantor allow Grantees, their agents, employees, licensees, invitees, guests, owners and occupants (collectively "Occupants") of said Benefitted Parcel a permanent access easement over and across the Grantor Parcel in the area depicted on Exhibit C-1, as further described on Exhibit C-2 attached hereto (the "Easement Parcel") for the passage and accommodation of vehicles and pedestrians to and from Ketch Road to the Benefitted Parcel.
D. Grantor is willing to grant the Easement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.
NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, including the recitals and mutual promises, covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto hereby agree as

- 1. <u>Grant of Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to the Grantee, their successors and assigns, and the Occupants, a perpetual non-exclusive easement over the Easement Parcel for vehicular and pedestrian ingress and egress to and from Ketch Road to the Benefitted Parcel. Grantor may use the Easement Parcel for any purpose that does not materially interfere with the use of the Benefitted Parcel by the Grantees and Occupants as described in this Easement.
- Amintenance. The Grantee may construct and maintain, or cause to be maintained, at their sole cost and expense, a gravel driveway on the Easement Parcel, and shall be obligated to keep the Easement Parcel and said driveway in a clean and sightly condition ("Maintenance"). The cost of the Maintenance of the Easement Parcel (the "Maintenance Costs") shall be paid by Grantee until such time (i) this Easement is terminated, as contemplated below, or (ii) Grantor permits the addition of other benefitted parcels, at which time the Maintenance Costs shall be shared equally between all parties entitled to use of the Easement Parcel.
- 3. Restoration. If, as a result of the exercise of any easement rights created under this Easement, the improvements of Grantor are damaged or disturbed, Grantee shall, at its sole expense, promptly repair or restore the improvements to, as nearly as possible, the condition existing prior to such damage or disturbance.
- 4. <u>Termination</u>. Grantor and Grantee agree that in the event a public road, duly established and dedicated, is constructed such that Grantee shall have access to Ketch Road from the Benefitted Parcel, this Easement shall automatically terminate. Grantor also acknowledges that no more than one access point to Ketch Road from the Entire Parcel is permitted, and agrees that it shall not establish, or attempt to establish, access to Ketch Road from the Grantor Parcel without establishing use of any such access by the Benefitted Parcel and causing an agreed termination of this Easement. In the event that this future access for the Entire Parcel becomes necessary, its specific location shall be in accordance with the Union County Engineer's discretion and Access Management Regulations.
- 5. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This Easement shall be binding upon Grantee and Grantor, and their respective heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns.
- 6. Notices. All notices and communications required or permitted to be given or delivered under this Agreement shall be given or delivered in writing and shall be given in person, by deposit in the United States mail, certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, or by overnight delivery with a nationally recognized overnight delivery service. Notice shall be delivered at the addresses set forth as follows or as a party may hereafter designate in writing:

Miscellaneous.

- (A) Governing Law. This Easement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio.
- (B) Amendment. This Easement may only be amended, supplemented, terminated or otherwise modified, in writing, signed by Grantor and Grantee.
- (C) <u>Covenants Run With Land</u>. This Easement shall be perpetual in nature, shall run with and shall be appurtenant to the Benefitted Parcel, and shall burden the Grantor Parcel.
- (D) <u>Legal and Equitable Remedies Available</u>. In the event of a breach or threatened breach by any party hereto (collectively, jointly and severally, a "<u>Defaulting Party</u>") of any of the terms, covenants, restrictions or conditions hereof, the other party(s) shall be entitled forthwith to full and adequate relief by injunction and all such other available legal and equitable remedies from the consequences of such breach from the Defaulting Party, provided however, that no breach hereunder shall entitle any party hereto to cancel, rescind or otherwise terminate this Easement.
- (E) No Merger. There shall be no merger of the easements granted, established and created hereby with the fee estate of any party hereto, by reason of the fact that any person may own or hold (a) the estate or interest encumbered by this Easement and (b) the fee estate of the Grantee Parcel or any portion thereof; and no such merger shall occur until all the fee owners of both the Grantor Parcel and the Grantee Parcel, execute a written statement or instrument affecting such merger and duly record the same.
- (F) <u>Exhibits/Recitals</u>. Each Exhibit referred to in this Easement and the Recitals are hereby incorporated herein by reference.



Engineer's Office Update – Jeff Stauch:

- This month contract projects will be starting. The Claibourne Road bridge will be officially closing today for repairs. Later this month, MP Dory will start working on the guardrail program. Also starting are the hot mix paving project and the pavement marking project.
- The small bridge replacement on McKitrick Road is starting this week.
- The portion of Cherry Road that was closed for the bridge replacement is now open, but the city still has another portion closed for their repairs.

- Road crews will be starting to widen nine miles of road using recycled milling from other jobs in a pug mill. If this goes well, they will continue to do this in the future.
- Commissioner Robinson asked what roads they will be widening, and Mr. Stauch stated part of Unionville Road, Osbourne Road, Snare Road, Woods Road, and Fish-Daum Road.
- He had a joint call with ODNR, ODOT, and the consultant for the Streng Road Bridge replacement. They have selected an alignment and will provide pictures to discuss this with the Board. The goal is to improve the intersection, and the new alignment will do that. The environmental consultant is surveying mussels this week or early next week.
- The office was successful in receiving 2027 CORPO grant funds for paving Industrial Parkway. By receiving this grant, less grant funds from CEAO (County Engineers Association of Ohio) will be used.
- They will be applying for OPWC grant funds. If received, the funds will be used for the Sander Road Bridge project.
- Commissioner McCarthy asked where this bridge was located, and Mr. Stauch stated it crosses into Delaware County. This is a very large bridge, and it will be expensive for the repairs that are needed. They have applied for this grant in the past but have not received any funds.

Ginger Yonak arrived at this time.

- He will be traveling to Plain City later today to discuss their Comprehensive Plan. There has been an increase in requests for pedestrian crosswalks on roads in Union County. The Engineer's Office is looking at each request individually. Location and speed limits are considered to make sure the crosswalks can be placed in safe locations.
- Mr. Narducci stated there is the potential for a roundabout or traffic light with pedestrian crossing to be added to the intersection at Brock Road and Industrial Parkway.
- Commissioner Robinson asked how there can be pedestrian crossing at a roundabout, and Mr. Stauch stated there are crosswalks installed on the curbs.
- Commissioner McCarthy asked if LUC could come up with plans for sidewalks and trails during the planning phases of development project, and Mr. Narducci stated that the Health Department and other agencies are part of the initial meeting with developers. Pedestrian infrastructure is discussed and planned during those meetings.
- Mr. Stauch stated he met with an architecture and engineering firm last week for the site and feasibility study proposal for additions to the Operations facility. There is not enough room in the current facility for all the tandem trucks and there is only one restroom for 30 staff members during construction season.
- He will be out next week on vacation. He asked to contact Jessica Cain if something is needed.
- A fiber installation company has sued Madison County Engineer's Office and the Engineer personally. The company caused extensive damage and the Engineer's Office shut them down.
- Commissioner McCarthy stated this emphasizes the importance of requiring performance bonds for utility installation in the right of way.



WITNESSETH, that the Contractor, the Board of County Commissioners and the Owner for the considerations stated herein mutually agree as follows:
