OVERVIEW

- Union County-Marysville Economic Development, similarly to most Economic Development Orgs in the state, respond to and maintain a list of project leads
- In early stages, leads are confidential and typically use aliases
- This is because site selectors and project managers are typically looking at multiple sites across the USA and even abroad. They do not want project news to be leaked before company decisions are finalized
- We also receive leads from regional and local partners, brokers, and companies reaching out directly



KEY DEFINITIONS

Site Selectors & Brokers

Consultants or advisors hired by companies to help choose where to locate or expand a facility. They evaluate communities, sites, costs, and incentives

Leads

Potential business opportunities- investment, jobs, payroll

RFI (Request for Information)

An early-stage document sent by a company or site selector to gather basic information about a community or site, such as workforce, utilities, and available land

LEAD GENERATION **PROCESS**

- We do not submit for every lead as we evaluate how a company would “fit” in our community
- We typically have a deadline of 3 days to 2 weeks to complete an RFI
- Requires coordination and consensus between and among utilities, the city, Union County, schools, Jobs Ohio, and One Columbus
- Our goal is to secure a community tour and site/building visit

WHAT GOES IN AN **RFI?**

When we fill out an RFI to submit a project, we usually provide the following information for each site we submit:

- Property owner details
- Neighboring companies and uses
- Site size
- Zoning requirements
- Environmental regulations and protection areas (if present)
- Electric provider, capacity, and details
- Gas provider, capacity, and details
- Water and Wastewater provider, capacity, and regulations
- Fire suppression systems in place
- Access to the site, including adjacent roads and closest highways and airports
- Educational assets
- Tax rates
- Community demographics and details, occasionally information about Columbus, as well
- Local and state incentive availability

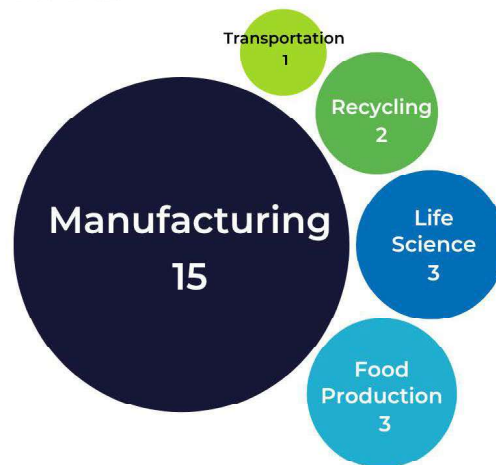

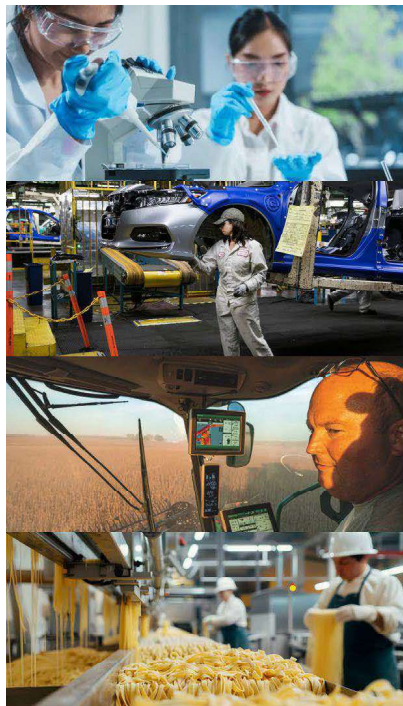
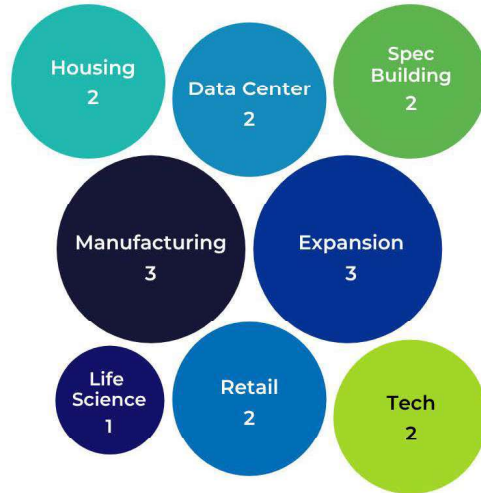

Subject: Meijer Jerome – Application for Variance Justification Narrative

The following is a list of the requested variances for this project. Also, listed below are explanations as to why the variances are being requested.

Variance #1 - Section 406 Road or Street Right-of-Way and Pavement Widths:

"Pavement Widths shall not be less than those widths specified in the Technical Design Standards of the County Engineer."

Technical Design Standards Section 101.I: "Minimum Pavement Width for a local street with curb and gutter is 28 feet".

Requested Variance: Approval to reduce the minimum pavement width for a local street with curb and gutter from 28 feet to 24 feet.

Explanation / Justification: The requested variance is due to practical difficulty created by the expected traffic volumes and functional classification of the internal roadway. The proposed pavement width adequately accommodates two-way traffic, service vehicles, and emergency access for a private internal drive serving a single commercial development. Strict compliance with the minimum pavement width would increase impervious area and site disturbance without providing a corresponding safety or operational benefit. The reduced pavement width also helps to slow traffic along this internal access drive thereby increasing safety across the development interconnection. The reduced pavement width meets the intent of the Technical Design Standards by maintaining safe and efficient circulation while minimizing unnecessary pavement.

Variance #2 - Section 408.3 Permanent Dead End Streets:

"Permanent dead end streets shall not be permitted. Temporary dead end streets shall be permitted only as a part of a continuing street plan subject to extension into undeveloped acreage. Temporary dead end streets shall extend to the boundary of such undeveloped acreage or as required by the Regional Planning Commission. The Regional Planning Commission may limit the length of such temporary dead end streets. The Regional Planning Commission may require a street along the boundary between the proposed subdivision and the undeveloped acreage to provide for future development."

Requested Variance: Approval to permit a dead-end street configuration along the north lot line of Developer Outlot 6 in lieu of extending a public street or constructing a cul-de-sac.

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Explanation / Justification: The requested variance is due to site-specific constraints and the planned access configuration for both the proposed development and adjacent properties. The dead-end street condition is limited in length, does not create unsafe circulation patterns, and does not impede emergency access. While the street access easement is technically a dead end, the site configuration allows for the street to open into the private parking facility thereby allowing for circulation of emergency vehicles. Strict compliance would require roadway construction that is not warranted by current or foreseeable development patterns and would not improve connectivity or public safety. The proposed configuration allows for orderly development of the site while preserving flexibility for future access coordination, consistent with the intent of Section 408.3.

Variance #3 - Section 406 Road or Street Right-of-Way and Pavement Widths:

"Minimum Right-of-Way Width for a Local Street or Road is 60 feet."

Requested Variance: Approval to reduce the minimum right-of-way width for a local street from 60 feet to 50 feet.

Explanation / Justification: The requested variance is due to the function of the proposed roadway as an internal access drive serving the development rather than a higher-order public street or marginal access road. While a marginal access configuration could function with a reduced right-of-way width of approximately 40 feet, the proposed design provides a 50-foot right-of-way to accommodate pavement, curb and gutter, sidewalks, utilities, and drainage features while maintaining flexibility for long-term operations and maintenance. Requiring additional right-of-way beyond 50 feet would result in unnecessary grading, increased impervious surface, and site impacts without providing a corresponding safety or operational benefit. The proposed right-of-way width exceeds what would be required for marginal access purposes and meets the intent of Section 406 by supporting safe circulation, access management, and infrastructure needs while avoiding unnecessary infrastructure and environmental impacts.

Variance #4 - Section 413.4 Through Lots:

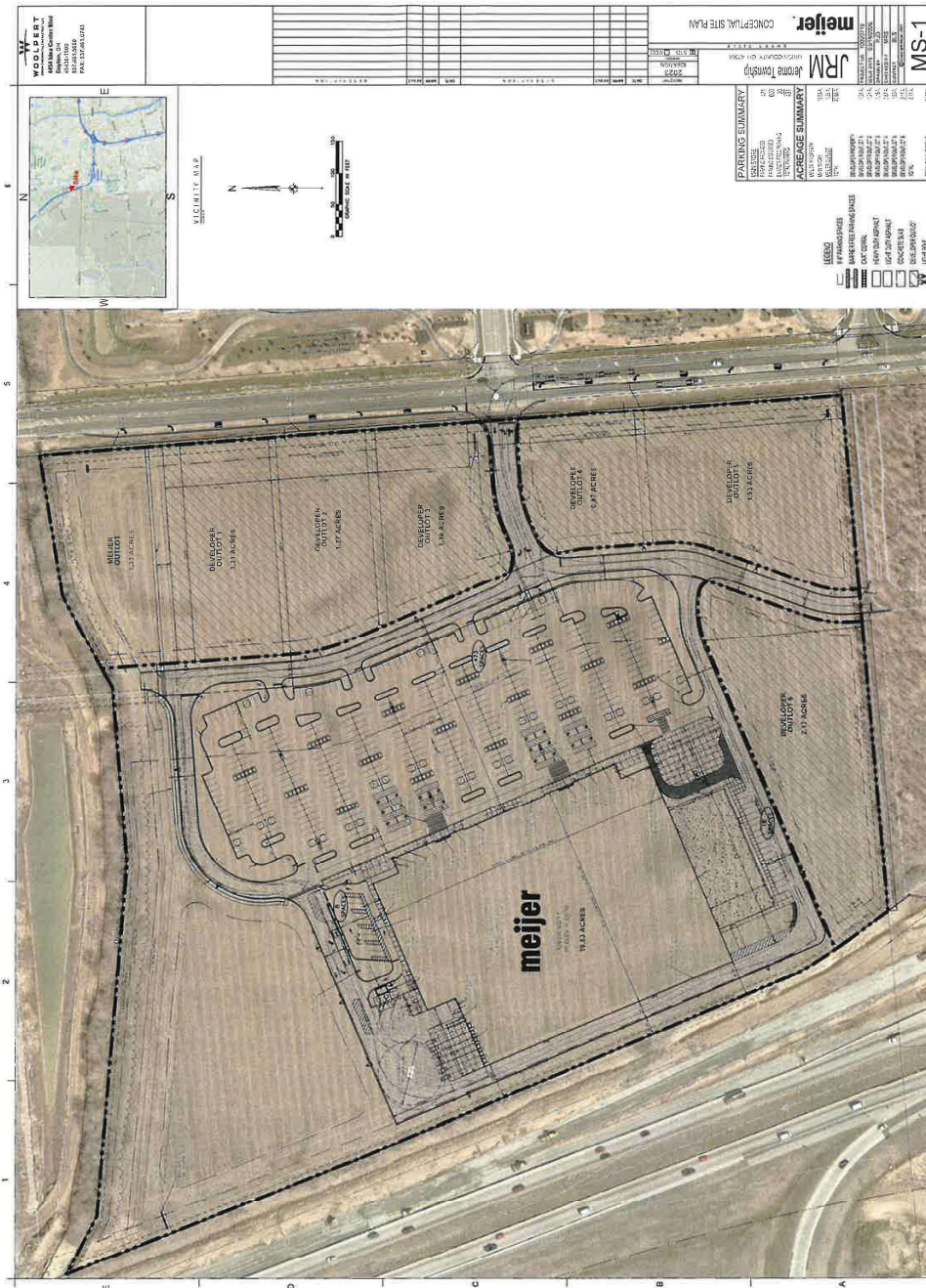
"Through Lots shall be avoided except where the Regional Planning Commission determines that it is essential to provide separation of residential development from arterials or collectors."

Requested Variance: Approval to allow through lots fronting Hyland-Croy Road and adjacent to U.S. Route 33.

Explanation / Justification: The requested variance is due to the commercial nature and scale of the proposed development. Through-lot configurations are common and appropriate in large-format commercial developments where lots must orient to multiple roadways for access, visibility, and circulation. The concerns typically associated with through lots—such as conflicts between front and rear yard uses—are primarily residential in nature and do not apply in this context. Allowing through lots supports efficient site layout and access management while maintaining compatibility with adjacent roadways. The proposed configuration meets the intent of Section 413.4 by promoting orderly development without adversely affecting public safety, adjacent properties, or the general welfare.

Engineer's Office Update – Jeff Stauch, Engineer:

- He was able to use the snooper truck from ODOT to inspect the bridges on Quarry Road and Cherry Street. The truck allows for challenging inspection sites to be looked at more closely. The office applies for use of this truck every five years.
- The plans for the Brock Road roundabout are over 50% complete. The start date will be dependent on utilities.
- The office held spring training at the operations garage. Staff from HR, Ginger Yonak and Mackenzie Fisher, came and discussed benefits and answered questions for staff members.
- There will be changes made to the 811 utility location service in June.
- He is meeting with Garmin Miller, the architectural engineer firm working on the operations garage upgrade, later today.
- He has met with townships in southern Union County, Dover and Jerome, to discuss street paving and cost estimates. Richwood has also expressed interest in this as well.
- The asphalt bids received today will go towards 75 miles of county roads in the southern end of the county.
- He will continue to work on the throughfare plan.
- Chief Building Inspector, Sam Cronk, will be in for a Building Department update on May 27.
- He will be attending a diagnostic review for the Newton Perkins railroad crossings next week. This is a standard site review to discuss the need or potential for lights and gates.
- He has not been able to review the accident report from the accident on Osborne Road, but the office has replaced the existing signs with larger ones.
