**LEGAL NOTICE**

**TO:** Kristin N. Wiese, the mother of Darian Ruck and Layla Ruck:

**YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED, that:**

1. Union County Human Services (hereinafter also referred to as the “Agency”) has filed a Complaint involving minor children named Darian Ruck and Layla Ruck alleging that they are abused and/or dependent children, as defined in Ohio Revised Code Sections 2151.031(E) and 2151.04(C).
2. An abused child, as alleged in the Complaints and pursuant to R.C. 2151.031(E), is a child who, because of the acts of his parents, guardian, or custodian, suffers physical or mental injury that harms or threatens to harm the child’s health or welfare.
3. A dependent child, as alleged in the Complaints and pursuant to R.C. 2151.04(C), is a child whose condition or environment is such as to warrant the state, in the interests of the child, in assuming the child’s guardianship.
4. The Agency is requesting, if the child or children are found to be abused and/or dependent as defined above, that the Court Order the children be placed in the temporary custody of Union County Human Services or, in the alternative, that the Agency is granted protective supervision regarding these children. Other possible dispositions, as governed by Ohio Revised Code Section 2151.353 may include: (a) awarding legal custody of the children to either parent or any other person who, prior to the dispositional hearing, files a motion requesting legal custody; (b) committing the children to the permanent custody of Union County Human Services whereby your parental rights may be permanently terminated; or (c) placing the children in a permanent planned living arrangement with Union County Human Services if all conditions are met for the same to be imposed.

5. The Complaints are set for adjudication hearings on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April 2026 at 9:00 A.M. in the Union County Court of Common Pleas, Juvenile Division, Union County Courthouse, located at 215 West Fifth Street, Marysville, Ohio 43040. These cases are scheduled for disposition hearings on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026 at 1:30 P.M.
6. You are hereby required to attend said hearings at the above scheduled time and place.
7. You are entitled to have an attorney appointed to represent you. If you cannot afford an attorney, one may be appointed to represent you. If you desire to have an attorney appointed to you, you will need to contact the Union County Juvenile Court and complete a financial Affidavit. You may contact the Union County Juvenile Court at (937) 645-3029.
