**ENTRY GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INVENTORY
PENDING CONCLUSION OF LITIGATION**

Upon application, and for good cause shown, the Court finds that the Estate holds no assets subject to Probate at this time. The Court further finds that the appointment of the Fiduciary is for the filing of certain litigation.

Therefore, the Fiduciary shall not be responsible to file an Inventory within ninety (90) days of their appointment, in accordance with R.C. 2115.02, until the litigation is resolved.

The Fiduciary shall inform the Court of the progress of the litigation not later than one (1) year after appointment, and at least once annually every year thereafter upon the date of appointment, until the litigation is concluded.

Upon conclusion of the litigation, the Fiduciary shall notify the Court within thirty (30) days of the resolution and report when the Inventory will be filed.

Absent further order of the Court, the Inventory shall be filed not later than ninety (90) days after the conclusion of the civil litigation.
