Residential Building Permit Requirements

In order to obtain a building permit for your project, you will need to complete the following steps:

• Complete the applicable online permit application

www.unioncountyohio.gov/engineer

- Obtain plan approval
- Obtain zoning approval from applicable township / municipality
- Obtain site plan approval from the Union County Health Department for properties with well and/or septic
- Pay all applicable plan review & permit fees

How to complete the permit application:

- All applications must be completed on our <u>website portal</u>.
- Plumbing, well & septic approvals are completed through the Union County Health Department (www.uchd.net/plumbing)

What are the applicable plan review and permit fees?

- <u>Plan Review Fee</u>: A *nonrefundable* permit application fee and plan review fee will be due at the time of application. Payable to Union County Building Department. A 1% fee will be collected on behalf of Ohio Board of Building Standards to all permit fees.
- <u>Permit Fees</u>: Fees will be comprised of any and all applicable trades and based on square footage of the project. Including but not limited to: building, electrical, and mechanical. A 1% fee will be collected on behalf of Ohio Board of Building Standards to all permit fees. (*All fees can be found on our County website*)

How to submit your plans for review

Digital submittal – Upload the complete set of drawings to the attachments of your application. Please review the Residential Digital Plan Review Application Checklist located on our <u>website</u> regarding what is required for review and in what order.

How to schedule an inspection

There are currently two ways to schedule an inspection:

- 1. Directly through OpenGov. This allows for a 7 AM cutoff time for same business day inspections.
- 2. Call our inspection line at 937-645-3019. You will need to know the permit number, address and type of inspection needed. Please note, this method can take **two business days** for inspection scheduling. If the timing of your inspection is critical, please use the inspection option with Opengov.
