

How do I know my drive access type?

Residential Drive Access & Address Permit or Roadside

No Drive access - Address Only – This permit is used when only an Address is needed.

- State Route: This permit will be for the address only. Drive access must be obtained from ODOT. Ohio Department of Transportation District 6 - Stewart Squires- 740-833-8000. ODOT approval will need to be provided before address will be assigned.
- Utility Facility: This permit will be for utility facility (cabinets/enclosures) locations that do not require a driveway.

Single Family Residence – This permit is used to access a single-family residential lot, servicing only one residence.

Single Family Residential Common Access Drive serving 5 or less residents – This permit is used to access 5 or less single-family residential lots. This will be a shared, Common Access Drive.

Roadside Pipe – This permit is used when choosing to fill in a roadside ditch with a new or replacement roadside ditch pipe. This option does not include drive access.

Field Drive Access – This permit is used only to access Agricultural land, no farm buildings or residential properties.

Farm Drive Access – This permit is used to access Agricultural buildings only.

Utility Facility with drive access– This permit is used when a Utility facility (cabinets/enclosures) needs drive access. Drive access for larger building sites (i.e. cell towers, sub stations) will need to use the Commercial Drive Access Application.

Multi - Family Residence serving 5 or less residents – This permit is used to access a multi- family residential lot, servicing 5 or less residences.

Commercial Drive Access & Address Permit

No Drive access - Address Only – This permit is used when only an Address is needed.

- State Route: This permit will be for the address only. Drive access must be obtained from ODOT. Ohio Department of Transportation District 6 - Stewart Squires- 740-833-8000. ODOT approval will need to be provided before address will be assigned.

Commercial Low Volume Drive access – This permit is for access to Commercial properties with less than 100 trips per peak hours.

Commercial Medium Volume Drive access – This permit is for access to Commercial properties with more than 100 but less than 200 trips per peak hours.

Commercial High-Volume Drive access - This permit is for access to Commercial properties with 200 or more trips per peak hours.

Temporary Drive access - This permit is for temporary/construction access to a property. Once access is no longer needed the drive will be removed.
