of the proceedings Relative to the advertising selling and conveying  
Lands delinquent for tax prior to the year 1820 within the  
County of Union and State of Ohio  
Whereas the Legislature of the State of Ohio did on the twenty  
ninth day of January in the year of Our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and twenty seven pass an act entitled an  
act for the remission of penalties and for the sale of lands  
for taxes, by which act it is made the duty of the Auditor  
of each County on or before the first day of August one  
thousand eight hundred and twenty eight to proceed to  
compare all the lands within his County on which taxes  
were due or on which taxes had not been paid prior to the  
year one thousand eight hundred and twenty with the dupli-  
cates and other documents in his Office and from such com-  
parison and other information as he may be able to procure,  
make such corrections in such delinquent lands as to him  
may appear just and proper, which list of lands he should  
immediately thereafter transmit to the Auditor of State.  
That the Auditor of State should immediately after receiving  
from the respective County Auditors, a list of lands upon  
which the arrearages of taxes remained due and unpaid  
prior to the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty  
as aforesaid compare the same with the duplicates and  
other documents in his Office and transmit to the several  
County Auditors a correct list of all the lands within  
their respective Counties on which arrearages of taxes  
were due and unpaid previous to the year one thousand  
eight hundred and twenty whether such lands have  
or have not been forfeited to the State charging each  
tract or part of tract with all such arrearages of tax  
and interest which may actually remain due and  
unpaid prior to that time and add to such charge

any taxes, penalties and interest which might have accrued on such lands since the commencement of the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty which list he shall certify under his Official seal and transmit to the Auditor of the proper County. Provided that no tax shall be received at the Office of the Treasurer of State on said list after the said first day of August eighteen hundred and twenty eight.

That the Auditor of each County on receiving from the Auditor of State a list of lands within his County as aforesaid on which the taxes have not been paid prior to the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty with the tax interest and penalties subsequent to that time charged thereon shall in case the same be not paid on or before the fifteenth day of October eighteen hundred and twenty eight forthwith thereafter cause Notice thereof to be advertised four weeks successively in a news paper printed in his County if any such there be and if not in some newspaper in general circulation therein to all concerned that if the tax interest and penalties charged on said list be not paid into the County Treasury and the Treasurers receipt produced therefor before the time specified by this act for the sale of said land which day should be named in said Notice that then and in that case the lands so as aforesaid delinquent on which the tax interest and penalties might remain unpaid would on the second Monday of December thereafter be exposed to sale at the Court house or usual place of holding Courts in such County in order to satisfy said tax interest and penalties, and the Auditor in each County shall on said second Monday of December attend at the Court house or usual place of holding Courts in his County and proceed to sell the whole of
