#### DEPARTMENT OF AUDITOR OF STATE.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, April 16, 1906.

TO COUNTY AUDITORS AND TREASURERS:

In order to secure uniformity of method in the matter of the assessment and collection of the Liquor Traffic Tax, the Bureau of Inspection and Supervision of Public Offices has prescribed the form of duplicate mailed you herewith, to be hereafter used in the several Counties of the State, and in order that it may be readily understood and applied, you will please comply with

The duplicates should be classified by cities, villages, or townships, and in column 1 the names should be entered alpha-

In columns 2, 3, 4, and 5 entries should be made as indicated, for each dealer:

In column 6 should be entered all assessments reported as uncollected on the Fourth Monday of May, as shown in column 32, of the last year's duplicate:

In column 7, show only amounts assessed against the dealers making voluntary application as of the Fourth Monday of May; total being line 1 July settlement sheet:

In column 8 enter only the \$500.00 assessments against the dealers who make application, voluntarily, as of the Fourth

In column 9, enter all assessments made after Fourth Monday of May and prior to July settlement, including assessments and penalties certified by Auditor of State under provisions of Section 4364-14  $\alpha$ :

In column 10, enter 20% penalty on all assessments if not paid when due:

In column 11, enter total of amounts found in columns 6, 7, 9 and 10, and also carry into this column the gross amount collected after the last January settlement, and prior to the Fourth Monday of May for each taxing district; total being line 5, July settlement sheet. See column 31 last year's duplicate:

In column 12, enter date of all discontinuances prior to the July settlement:

In column 13, enter amounts refunded, always retaining at least \$200.00 in the treasury, where the dealer did not continue in business 73 days, and also carrying into this column the gross amount refunded after the last January settlement, and prior to the Fourth Monday of May. See column 29:

In column 14, enter amounts remitted prior to July settlement:

In column 15, enter all dates of payment prior to July settlement:

In column 16, Treasurer should enter all amounts collected prior to July settlement, including gross collections after the last January settlement, and prior to the Fourth Monday of May:

In column 17, enter all amounts unpaid at time of July settlement:

In column 18, enter all assessments made after July settlement and prior to January settlement, including assessments and penalties certified by the Auditor of State under the provisions of Section 4364-14a:

In coumn 19, enter 20% penalty on all assessments not paid when due:

In column 20, enter total of the amounts in columns 17, 18 and 19:

In columns 21, 23 and 24 entries should be made as the headings suggest:

In column 22, enter amounts refunded, always retaining at least \$200.00 in the treasury, where the dealer did not continue in business 73 days:

In column 25, Treasurer should enter all collections made between July and January settlements:

In column 26, show all amounts charged and uncollected at time of January settlement:

In column 27, enter all assessments made after the January settlement and prior to the Fourth Monday of May, including assessments and penalties certified by the Auditor of State under the provisions of Section 4364-14a:

In column 28, enter 20% penalty on all assessments not paid when due:

In column 29, enter amount of refunders issued after January settlement and prior to Fourth Monday of May:

In column 20, enter date of payment after January settlement and prior to Fourth Monday of May:

In column 31, enter amount collected after January settlement and prior to Fourth Monday of May. The amounts collected and entered in this column should be carried forward in one cash item, by taxing districts, to columns 11 and 16 of next year's

In column 32, enter all assessments remaining unpaid, including penalty, on the Fourth Monday of May, which assessments should be carried forward, in separate items, to column 6 of the next year's duplicate:

In column 33, where dealers sell out to others, enter names of successors at that location:

Persons making application within 73 days before the close of the year must be asse refunded in case of discontinuance,

In no instance permit a dealer to transfer from one location to another, from one person to another, or to change the name of the firm. Treat such cases as discontinuances, and require new applications.

County Auditors should refuse to issue a refunder for discontinuance except upon the affidavit of the dealer and the surrender of the Treasurer's receipt, and in no case should the refunder be issued to an assignee.
