
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
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

WHEREAS, at a court holden by us on the *8<sup>th</sup>* day of *Oct* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty *seven* at the court house in Marysville, in the county aforesaid, *Sofias Miller* of said county, as is alleged, lately died intestate, having whilst living, and at the time of *his* death, goods and chattels, within this state and county, by means whereof, ordering and granting administration of all and singular the said goods and chattels, and also the auditing, allowing and final discharging the account thereof, doth appertain to us; and we being desirous that the goods and chattels of the deceased may be well and truly administered, applied and disposed of, do grant unto the said *Silas G Strong*
