Union County Agency Transportation Service (UCATS) is dedicated to transporting Union County residents to medical and personal appointments. We currently transport people on behalf of Union County Job and Family Services, Senior Services, the Veterans Services Commission, and clients with ADA defined disabilities.

First time riders can either fill out the '*New Rider Digital Form*' on our website or contact our dispatcher at (937) 642-5100. To schedule trips with UCATS you can either contact our dispatcher or fill out our online '*Transportation Request Form*'. Trip requests are on a First Come, First-Serve basis where we need at least 24-hour notice for in-county requests, and at least 3 business days (72 hours) for out-of-county requests. Any special accommodations or disabilities should be disclosed on our digital forms or with the dispatcher at the time of scheduling.
