4/11/2025	01:13	Assist Other Agency / Human Trafficking	Deputies assisted the Richwood Police in locating a suspect vehicle from an attempted break-in of an ATM at a bank on North Franklin Street. Deputies stopped a 2012 Ford Fiesta on US Route 33 near Northwest Parkway. At the request of Richwood Police, deputies arrested the driver, Mario N. Perez, age 27, and the passenger, Renny M. Sojo-Delgado, age 26, both out of Chicago, Illinois, for safe cracking, possessing criminal tools and unauthorized use of property. Also in the vehicle was a 14-year-old juvenile from Chicago, Illinois. A representative from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services was called to the sheriff's office to take custody of the juvenile. Perez and Sojo-Delgado were both transported to the Tri County Regional Jail, and a report was taken #2025-00012863.
