10/15/2025	07:55	Injury Crash	Deputies along with units from the Jerome Township Fire Department, Washington Township Fire Department and the Pleasant Valley Joint Fire District, responded to US Route 33 near State Route 161 to investigate an injury crash. The crash involved a 2009 Hyundai Sonata that was struck from behind by a 2020 Ram 1500, causing the Hyundai to strike the rear of a 2010 BMW 135 which in turn struck the rear of a 2022 Hyundai Kona. Two people were transported to Dublin Methodist Hospital. The driver of the Ram 1500, Lane A. McKinney, age 34 of Marysville, was issued a traffic citation for failure to maintain an assured and clear distance ahead. A crash report was taken, #2025-00037012.
