The driver, Shane E. Allen, age 42 of South Charleston, attempted to flee the scene on foot but was apprehended by deputies and troopers. He was transported to Memorial Hospital and has been charged with failure to control, obstructing official business, resisting arrest, and operating a vehicle while under the influence.
