2/5/2022	10:00	Injury Crash	A deputy and units from the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Jerome Township Fire Department, Washington Township Fire Department, and the Pleasant Valley Joint Fire District responded to US Route 33 near Brock Road for an injury crash involving a 2012 Chevrolet Silverado that drove off the road, struck a snowbank, and rolled over onto its top. The driver, Christopher T. Glass age 42 of Richwood, was issued a traffic citation for failure to control. A crash report was taken, #80-22-065.
2/5/2022	16:55	Trespassing	A deputy was dispatched to a residence in the 18000 block of Broad Street in Broadway to investigate a trespassing complaint involving snowmobiles operating on private property without permission. No report was taken.
2/5/2022	17:46	Property Damage Crash	A deputy investigated a property damage crash that occurred on US Route 33 west of Scottslawn Road involving 2020 Honda CR-V that was struck by ice that flew off of a 2022 GMC Acadia. It was determined the crash occurred in the City of Marysville and the parties were referred to the Marysville Police Department.
2/5/2022	17:55	Arrest Warrant	A deputy met with a Columbus Police Officer to take custody of Ashlei N. Hollingsworth, age 37 of Columbus for an outstanding arrest warrant. She was transported to the Tri County Regional Jail.

2/5/2022	19:59	Dispute	Deputies were dispatched to a residence in the 13000 block of US Route 36 to investigate a domestic dispute between several family members. No report was taken.
2/5/2022	20:04	Injury Crash / Impaired Driver	While on patrol in the 20000 block of White Stone Road, a deputy came across an injury crash involving a 2000 Chevrolet S-10 that lost control, drove off the road, and rolled over in a field. After further investigation, the driver, Jonathan TR Stillings, age 25 of Marysville was arrested for operating a vehicle while under the influence. He was also charged with driving under suspension and failure to control. He was transported to the Sheriff's Office and two reports were taken, #22-0099 and #80-22-066. Deputies were assisted at the scene by units from the Ohio State Highway Patrol, the Marysville Fire Department, and the Leesburg Township Fire Department.
